Recorded by our producer Bob McDowall, when he was over in Toronto for the 'Folk Alliance', this is the first time that P/M Michael Grey has worn the head-honcho hat. As you might expect, knowing Michael's love of all things Celtic, and Cape Breton in particular, the album features a much strengthened band (and getting among the prizes) on the expected, stirring traditional band repertoire AND the unexpected as they 'sing', there's some 'dancing' and some quite excellent twists and turns in the piping and drumming.

The 'waulking' by the way, and for the uninitiated, is not a mis-print and not about 'plod', 'the old bill', 'cops' or those wonderful chaps who task it is to uphold the laws of the land 'walking the beat'. Waulking is the rhythmic method used when thrashing wool into a usable form to make cloth.

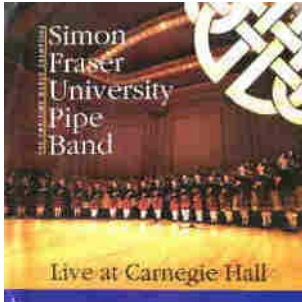

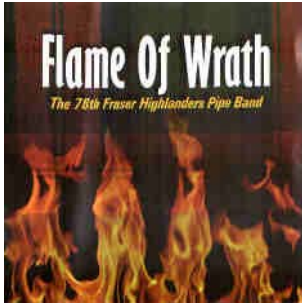

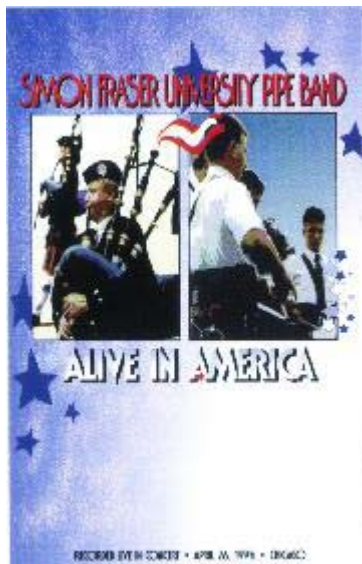

It takes grit and determination to travel annually, with a party of 20-30 people, from British Columbia (on Canada's far-away West Coast) to Glasgow, Scotland to play your kind of music your way for approximately 8-10 minutes and take the audience reaction on the chin, as it comes. But there are two audiences. One is the thousands of spectators who regularly attend 'The World Pipe Band Championship' and show great appreciation of the 150+ bands who compete. The other 'audience' numbers only 4 but is, by far, more important to all of the bands than the assembled multitude. These select few are the judges, and on their markings of these few minutes of toil each pipe band's year can be made or destroyed.

How would you feel? A twelve thousand mile round-trip, a stunning performance and 'pipped' by half-a-point!

Would you even consider doing it? This is more harrowing than anything the 'Tartan Army' ever had to endure. You can't even cheer or chant your favourites on. You can only stand still and listen. Even the relative anonymity of the judges means that you cannot question their sight, hearing or parentage! What a bummer!

The Simon Fraser University Pipe Band have made this trip a dozen times. And, yes, they have the T-shirts.

In August 1995, when the judges tallied up all of the marks there was the hushed audience, there was the subtly brief pause "and the New World Champions are"
