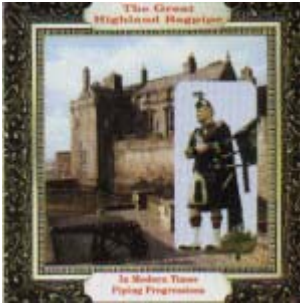

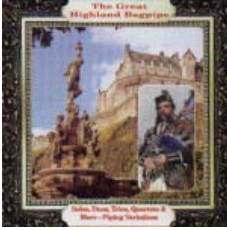
Some of the directions being forged by pipers and bands. From within the folk and world music markets to simply making a much maligned instrument sound normal and putting the pipes into regular musical pieces.
